Fourth Sunday of Lent ~ March 10, 2024

"But the Lord said to Samuel: 'Do not judge from his appearance or from his lofty stature, because I have rejected him. Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance but the Lord looks into the heart.'"

Remember the prayer of Solomon, asking God for the gift of right judgement? We spend much time judging people, their motives, their gifts and faults. How do we look at ourselves? As we read the book of Samuel as God is preparing for David for His people, we learn that we should judge with the eyes of God, what He sees in us, and not just the appearance.

Lent is our special opportunity to look deep into our heart to see what He sees, and root out what is displeasing, or shouldn't be there. Jesus came to assist us in this task.

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION CEMETERY

During the gusty winds of the past two weeks, a tree fell in the cemetery behind the social hall. The tree toppled a few headstones and took out a portion of fencing. The tree will be removed as soon as possible and we will assess any damage to the headstones. Presently the ground is too wet and

muddy to do the work. If we try to do it now, we are going to ruin more graves.

Since the falling tree was not the responsibility of any lot owner, we will file an insurance claim to right, repair, and if necessary, replace any stone involved. However, if the foundation upon which the headstone rests has shifted naturally, the lot owner will be informed.

This is an expense to be incurred by the lot owner not the parish. The parish will right the stone and place it back on its foundation BUT in the future the ground could shift enough to naturally bring the stone down. If this occurs, the lot owner is financially responsible.


