

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION CEMETERY

During the gusty winds of the past two weeks, a tree fell in the cemetery behind the social hall. The tree toppled a few headstones and took out a portion of fencing. The tree will be removed as soon as possible and we will assess any damage to the headstones. Presently the ground is too wet and muddy to do the work. If we try to do it now, we are going to ruin more graves. Since the falling tree was not the responsibility of any lot owner, we will file an insurance claim to right, repair, and if necessary, replace any stone involved. However, if the foundation upon which the headstone rests has shifted naturally, the lot owner will be informed.

This is an expense to be incurred by the lot owner not the parish. The parish will right the stone and place it back on its foundation BUT in the future the ground could shift enough to naturally bring the stone down. If this occurs, the lot owner is financially responsible.
